Cumulative Grade point Average (CGPA) is the weighted average of all the grades and computed as follows:

$$CGPA = \frac{\sum C_i G_i}{\sum C_i}$$

C_i denotes Credits assigned to i th course and G_i indicates the Grade point equivalent to the Letter Grade obtained by the student to the i th course.

The division obtained by each student is classified on the following basis:

| <u>Division</u> | <u>CGPA</u> |
|----------------------------------|--------------------------------|
| 1 st with distinction | 8.5 or more |
| 1 st | 6.75 or more but less than 8.5 |
| 2 nd | 4.5 or more but less then 6.75 |

NOTE: The Percentage of marks obtained by a student be calculated as: CGPA multiplied by 9.00
