Please include any further information you believe to be relevant to your application and any required evidence to support your claims.</p>			
<p>1. Introduce yourself and your family Provide a brief introduction of yourself, your family and financial circumstances: Your name, age, residential location. Information about your family, such as: How many people in your family? What do your parents and siblings do for a living? Do you have family living in Australia? If so, what do they do and what type of visa do they hold in Australia Are you married or single?</p>			
<p>2. Marriage and/or Dependent Details (provide information only if married and/or have dependents) Include details about your spouse, including their education qualifications and occupation. Will they accompany you to Australia? Will they resign from their current employment? What will your spouse do in Australia? What is the registration date of your marriage? Do you have children? Will your children accompany you to Australia? If not, what are the living arrangements in your home country? Include the details you provided on your financial declaration form regarding the additional costs associated for your family to accompany you to Australia.</p>			
<p>3. Academic History and English Level Please provide brief details of your academic qualifications, full study history including year of commencement and year of completion and your English Proficiency Level (test results).</p>			

4. Study Gaps and Information about your work experience (if applicable)

What is the value of the program to you, what is your return on investment to the money and time spent studying your chosen program? Include your understanding of the program structure and content.

6. Why don't you want to study in your own country?

Are there similar programs offered in home country or any other country? provide details.

If your program of study is offered in your home country, why don't you study it there? How will this particular program you have chosen at Federation University differ from that in your home country, what are the benefits?

7. Study Motives – Why choose Federation University? Research about your Education provider

How did you hear about Federation University, what research did you complete on other education providers and why did you choose Federation University over other providers in Australia? What details do you know about Federation University and the teaching location of your choice?

8. Study Motives – Why choose Australia?

Why would you like to study in Australia? Provide strong reasons why Australia is the preferred destination over other countries and your own home country.

9. Education Outcome: What are your future plans?

How will this qualification benefit your future career in your home country? Please provide detailed research on your future career prospects in your home country (or other country), such as intended working area, targeted companies, job position, expected salary, etc.

Do you have an offer of employment, if not how will you seek employment on your return to your home country?

What are your intentions to return to home country, your ties such as family, community, economic circumstances, assets, future career plans?

10. Living arrangements in Australia

If your visa is granted, what will your living arrangements be in Australia? Please provide your plan in terms of accommodation, travel, work opportunities, and social networks with friends or relatives in Australia.

If you have any friends or relatives in Australia, please provide background information about them, such as residential location, occupation or other circumstances.

Please highlight your understanding of student visa conditions for international students.
